3. Then for the rest of the seats out of 100, the course will be allocated by the first-come-first-serve basis to the external students (students not from the unit offering the the course.)
4. For each course the maximum capacity is 100.
5. **Each student will be allowed to choose only one foundation course.**
6. Request to each academic units to advise their respective students to opt for foundation course registration on their own eGov portal accounts.
7. The portal will remain open **for Foundation Course registration from 10-14 Aug. '17**. Students from anywhere in campus can register for the course.
